

Poultry Waste Management Education Requirements

Registered poultry operators and certified poultry waste applicators are required to attend:

- *9 hours of initial education within the first year of becoming registered or licensed*
- and
- *2 hours of continuing education each year until receiving a total of 19 training hours.*

Upon receiving the 19 required hours, the operator or applicator will attain graduate status but shall be required to receive:

- *2 hours of continuing education every 3 years thereafter.*

If you became a graduate during 2015 you must attend a minimum of one continuing education class during the 3-year block:

Jan. 1, 2016 - Dec. 31, 2018
